Glass Storage



Thank you for purchasing the Storable Solutions Glass Storage. Your items will perform best when used as intended. To ensure the best performance of your products, please consistently follow these instructions.

PLEASE READ BEFORE USE AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WARNINGS

- Glass is fragile. Avoid impact to your storage and use caution with any impact from utensils.
- ♦ Do not use the lids in a conventional oven. Your lids can be used in the microwave, refrigerator and freezer.
- ♦ The glass storage is microwave, refrigerator and freezer safe. The storage is oven safe up to 450°F without the lid.
- If you are using your storage in the freezer, leave space between the top of the food and the lid. Freeze in small portions, as food expands when frozen and your glass storage may become damaged if it is filled too full before freezing.
- Do not use your glass storage on the stove or under any flame or direct heat source.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes to your storage. Always allow your storage to cool before using, serving, submerging into water, or placing in the freezer.
- Do not place hot storage onto a cool or wet surface immediately after using or while it is still hot. Always make sure to place the storage on a dry potholder or dry cloth that will minimize contact with a cold surface and allow time for cooling.
- ♦ Do not pour hot liquids into empty, cold glass storage and never add cold liquids into hot glass storage.
- ♦ Always allow the oven to fully preheat before putting your glass storage inside.
- ♦ Avoid cutting food inside the glass storage.
- Do not use your glass storage if it is chipped or cracked.
- ♦ Always use oven mitts or potholders when handling your hot storage and keep out of reach of children at all times.

GETTING STARTED

- Before using, remove any labels and wash and dry each item in accordance with the care and use instructions.
- Some of your storage items may feature dividers that allow you to store different types of food in the separate sections.

USING YOUR GLASS STORAGE

- ♦ Your glass storage can be used for cooking, baking, warming, and reheating foods in the microwave or oven up to 450°F without the lid.
- ♦ Always make sure the oven is preheated before inserting your glass storage and never use your plastic lid in the oven.
- ◆ To remove the lid on your glass storage, pull upwards on the clasps on the lid. To replace, push downwards on the clasps until they snap securely into place.
- If the storage has a divider, line up the divider on the lid to the one on the storage and push downwards on the clasps to properly seal your container. To remove, pull upwards on the clasps on the lid.



- When using your lids in the microwave, unlatch the lid and offset slightly over the glass storage to keep your food covered. It is recommended not to use your lids in the microwave for longer than 10 consecutive minutes.
- Please note: The silicone seal on the lid may come off when you open the lid. This is normal due to the tight seal between the lid and the storage. Simply replace the seal on the lid if this occurs.
- ♦ Always use extreme caution and use potholders or oven mitts when handling your hot storage.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes to the glass storage. After using and if hot, allow the storage to cool before washing or refrigerating.

CLEANING YOUR GLASS STORAGE

- ◆ Your glass storage is dishwasher safe. If you use a dishwasher to clean your items, load dishes to avoid bumping against other items during the dishwashing cycle and your lids should be placed on the top rack.
- Please note: handwashing with warm, soapy water is recommended to prolong the life of your glass storage.
- Do not use abrasive or harsh cleaners on your glass storage.
